

### Organisational Drivers

What evidence is there at an organisational policy level, both in terms of leadership and implementation to demonstrate a commitment to, or implementation of programmes or services intended to tackle or alleviate loneliness, social isolation and social exclusion?

#### Leadership Level

What evidence is there in terms of organisational or strategic policy, or other form of communication can you find expressing commitment to tackle loneliness, social isolation or social exclusion, as distinct social issues or as facets connected to wider health and social wellbeing in the context your organisation works in?

#### Implementation Level

What evidence is there at an implementation or service delivery level, regarding data, guidelines and operational policies, finance and resources, commissioning guidelines or operational standards or evaluation criteria, demonstrating an understanding of, and commitment to tackling loneliness, social isolation or social exclusion, either as discrete social issues or as part of programmes to promote and tackle wider health and social wellbeing?

### Competence Drivers

What evidence is there at an individual competence level in your organisation, or amongst partner organisations / populations that you work with to help address loneliness, social isolation and social exclusion. i.e. nominated champions or individuals leading on the issue, staff performance evaluation targets or training and coaching
